On perusal of the reply, which has been filed by the respondents, it appears that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with.

Learned senior counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that the juniors to the petitioner(s) are still getting higher pay and their pay has not been correctly fixed equal to that of their juniors nor have obviously the consequential benefits been released.

In case the submission, as made by the learned senior counsel for the petitioner(s), is correct, the petitioner(s) concerned may file a

within a period of three weeks from today. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided by the District Elementary Education Officer, Jind within a further period of five weeks by passing a speaking order. In case the claim of the petitioner(s) is accepted, the consequential benefits shall be released to them within a further period of six weeks.

The contempt petition, therefore, stands disposed of in above terms.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
