In the present contempt petition, it has been alleged that the judgment and decree as passed by the Sub-Judge Ist Class, Mandi Dabwali dated 09.01.1990 stands violated by the respondent vide order dated 02.05.2016 (Annexure P-4). Learned counsel for the petitioner has referred to the observations made in the said order to contend that the Civil Court judgment has not been complied with .

On considering the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and also keeping in view the fact that the appeal against the order dated 28.08.2015 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Dabwali, whereby an application under Order 9 Rule 13 CPC preferred by the Gram Panchayat against the petitioner was dismissed, is pending consideration. The present contempt petition, at this stage, is not maintainable and, therefore, the same stands dismissed.

If the petitioner is aggrieved, he may avail of his remedy, in accordance with law, against the order dated 02.05.2016.
