Petitioners have prayed for initiation of contempt proceedings on the ground that order dated December 02, 2015, passed by this court has been violated.

Operative part of the order reads as under:-

“Dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty. However, this Court has no doubt that demarcation will not give any right to respondent no.5 to take forcible possession. He will take possession only in accordance with law.”

It is urged before the court that respondent No.5 has taken forcible possession despite aforesaid direction. This court, however, finds no ground to interfere. It is evident that while disposing of the writ petition, this court had merely expressed the hope that forcible possession shall not be taken. Same would be only as per law. Under the circumstances, there is no merit in this petition.

Dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy. Needless to observe this course of action is always available to the petitioner.
