Reply by way of affidavit of Supreet Singh Gulati, ADC- respondent
no.3 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that the compliance has
been made and the amounts have been deposited in the account of the petitioners.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioners to controvert
the same.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied
with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as
having become satisfied, but with liberty to the petitioners to revive the same in
case of any dispute regarding the compliance. Rule against the respondents is
discharged.

Mr. Kataria, learned State counsel states that due to erroneous noting of the date the compliance could not be made in time and thus prays for waiving of the costs.

Let an appropriate application in this regard be filed giving the details so as to enable the Court to appreciate the decision of imposition of costs.

In the meantime, order imposing costs shall be kept in abeyance for two weeks only.
