Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh.Ram Kumar, Assistant, Deputy Commissioner Office, Kurukshetra, states that dues, on which statutorily or as per the instructions of the Government of Haryana, interest had to be granted, arrears have been released to the petitioner alongwith interest. Counsel for the petitioner disputes the said assertion.

If that be so, let a representation be filed by the petitioner to the

Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra, within a period of two weeks from today, detailing therein her grouse and claim, if any, which would be covered by the judgement passed by this Court. If such a representation is filed within the time stipulated, the Deputy Commissioner, Kurukshetra, shall consider the same and pass a speaking order within a further period of six weeks from the date of submission of the representation. In case any claim as made by the petitioner is accepted, consequential benefits be released to her within a further period of eight weeks. The representation of the petitioner shall be decided by passing a speaking order and be conveyed to her forthwith, who, if aggrieved by the said decision, may avail of her remedy in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged subject to above.
