AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner has approached this Court asserting non-compliance of order dated 20.11.2015 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court.

It is an admitted position that after passing of the said order dated 20.11.2015, it was conveyed to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, who has marked the same to the Superintendent of Police (D), Batala, to enquire into the matter. On that basis, the petitioner has been summoned on various occasions and his statement has also been recorded. This clearly shows that steps are being taken by the respondent in pursuance of the order passed by this Court.

Counsel for the petitioner asserts that till date neither any challan has been filed nor cancellation report submitted.

The order dated 20.11.2015 (Annexure P-1) does not indicate

such an action to be taken by the respondent. It, therefore, cannot be said that the order, Annexure P-1, has not been complied with or any violation thereof has been made.

The contempt petition is, therefore, dismissed.
