This order shall dispose of COCP Nos. 16 of 2015, 3555 of 2014, 17, 30 and 15 of 2015 as common question of law and facts are involved in all these petitions. However, the facts have been taken from COCP No.16 of 2015.

The grievance of the petitioners is that the order passed by this Court in CWP No.3189 of 2012 dated 3.3.2014 has not been complied with. It is not in dispute that vide order dated 12.4.2016, passed in the aforesaid writ petition subsequently three months' time has been granted to comply with the order.

Considering the aforesaid development, the present petitions are disposed of, at this stage, however, with liberty to the petitioners to get the same revived in case the order is not complied with within the time extended.
