Perusal of the reply which has been filed by the respondent, specially, Paras 6 and 7 thereof, it is apparent that the assertion of the complainant has been accepted and FIR No.171 dated 17.09.2015 has been registered.

In pursuance thereto Parkash Kumar S/o Ravinder Kumar resident of Village Jagatpura, stands arrested and in the disclosure statement dated 21.09.2015, during interrogation, led to the recovery of the snatched bag on 30.10.2014. Thereafter, efforts have been made for making the petitioner join the proceedings as her statement would be essential for identification of the purse and the goods therein, and for even identification of the accused but the petitioner has not joining the investigation. It appears that the petitioner is not further interested in pursuing the matter.

In any case, as far as the compliance of the order dated 09.03.2015, passed by this Court is concerned, in the considered view of this Court, keeping in view the reply which has been filed by the

respondent, to which no replication has been filed, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
