Grievance of the petitioner is that respondent has not complied with the order passed by the writ court in CWP No.13701 of 2013.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent, however, submits that order has now been complied with. He has referred to paras 4 and 5 of the affidavit filed by Smt. Sukriti Likhi, Managing Director, Haryana State Cooperative Supply & Marketing Federation Limited. Same reads as under:-

“4. That in compliance of this Hon'ble High Court order dated 02.03.2015, the matter was placed before Board of Directors (BOD) Hafed in its 356th meeting held on 15.06.2016 vide Agenda Item No.5. After persuasion of all the facts on record and after due deliberation, the BOD Hafed decided as under:

“Resolved that after due application of mind, the BOD of Hafed concurs with the decisions taken by BOA Hafed in its 252th meeting held on 11.04.2002 vide agenda item No.25 and

awards the punishment of removal from service and to recover Rs.4,40,581.28 from Sh. Mehtab Singh was allowed to rejoin service for the period 23.02.2004 to 31.12.2011, while the matter was subjudice. Therefore, the period from 23.10.2001 to 23.02.2004 i.e. from the date of dismissal to the date of rejoining in Hafed shall be treated as the period of dismissal. He cannot seek any payment for this period as he stood terminated and was not working for Hafed.”

The decision taken by the Board of Directors Hafed was conveyed to the petitioner vide memo No.Hafed/Admn/A-8/3381 dated 23.08.2016 (Annexure R-1).

5. By doing so, the answering respondent has complied with the order of the Hon'ble Court in letter and spirit.”

In view of above, no cause of action survives in this petition.

Same is hereby dismissed and rule is discharged.
