An unconditional apology has been tendered by the respondents in the affidavit dated 13.11.2015 filed in Court in response to the contempt petition for relieving the petitioner from duty because of inadvertence despite an interim order in favour of the petitioner. It has been stated that the petitioner joined duty on 29.07.2015 but unfortunately suffered a heart attack on 17.08.2015 and could not come present on duty till 21.09.2015. The petitioner has been granted the benefit of entire salary for the period 29.07.2015 to 31.07.2015 and thereafter from 01.08.2015 to 16.08.2015. Apart from that, petitioner has also been paid salary for the period 21.09.2015 to 31.10.2015 by cheque No.542173 dated 09.11.2015. Counsel for the respondents states that the petitioner is being regularly paid thereafter.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the respondents, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
