The writ petition, the interim order passed wherein alleged to have been violated, was dismissed in default. Hence, the interim stay automatically vacated. Though the writ petition has been restored on application filed by the petitioner, however, the interim stay was not restored. But the petitioner was permitted to file fresh application for stay.

Considering the aforesaid development, I do not find any reason to keep the present contempt petition pending. The same is accordingly dismissed.
