Learned counsel for the respondents seeks to place on record short reply by way of affidavit of Vishav Kant Garg, General Manager, Guru Nanak Dev Thermal Plant, Punjab.

Admittedly, an SLP No. 32240 of 2011 titled Punjab State Electricity Board now PSPC Ltd. and others Versus Kartar Singh and others preferred before the Hon'ble Supreme Court has been dismissed vide order dated 20.9.2016. Mr. Berry has referred to paras 4 and 5 of the reply filed today. The same reads as under:-

“4. That in view of the quashing of the impugned orders dated 12.10.1994 and 17.04.2002 by the Hon'ble Court, the said orders have been ordered to be withdrawn by the competent authority of Punjab State Power Corporation Limited vide its order No. 575 dated 22.09.2016. The copy of the said order is

enclosed herewith as Annexure R-1.

5. That in pursuance of the said order, the process of re-fixation of pay and refund of recoveries amount of the employees of the Corporation has been initiated and would be completed within reasonable period without any delay.”

He further submits, on instructions from Mr. Vishav Kant Garg, General Manager, that needful shall be done expeditiously, in any case not later than three months.

In view of the above, the grievance of the petitioner has been redressed.

Contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
