The writ petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of with a direction to the respondents therein to consider the claim of the petitioner made in the representation.

In response, affidavit of Arun Kumar Verma, MD, DHBVN, Hisar, dated 9.11.2015, has been filed, stating therein that after considering the representation filed by the petitioner, all admissible retiral benefits including the revised pension in terms of 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission have been paid. Details of the payment have also been furnished.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the method of calculation has not been furnished.

Only for the calculation purposes, the petition cannot be kept pending. However, the respondent is directed to furnish the detailed calculations to the petitioner. In case any amount still remains due to the petitioner, he may represent to the respondent for that purpose.
