In view of the above, the present petition is hereby disposed of with an observation that in case the petitioner complies with the provisions of Rule 14(iii) & (iv) of the Rules, as stated above, within a period of 15 days, the respondent(s) shall release the monthly financial assistance to her within 15 days thereafter.
