AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court alleging non-compliance of the order dated 20.02.2015 passed by this Court in *CWP No.20736 of 2013* titled as *Jaspal Singh Versus State of Haryana and others*.

A perusal of the said order would show that there is no mention whatsoever with regard to counting of service period of the petitioner or determination thereof in the said order, rather that was not an issue before the Court at all, the only issue before the Court was with regard to the earlier grant of seniority to the petitioner which was subsequently withdrawn by the impugned order dated 30.07.2013, which order was quashed by this Court. The claim, as has been sought to be projected in the present contempt petition, is counting of the service period for the grant of retiral benefits, which cannot be said to be the subject matter of the order dated 20.02.2015 passed in *CWP No.20736 of 2013* titled as *Jaspal Singh Versus State of Haryana and others*, therefore, there is no question of contempt having been committed by the respondent.

The petition, therefore, stands dismissed.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
