This petition is filed for the alleged disobedience of the order dated 5.02.2015 which was disposed of in terms of the order dated 31.08.2010 passed in CWP No. 2371 of 2010.

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the respondents have though complied with the order but it is only pertaining to the employees who are in service but not the employees who have either retired or died.

State counsel, on instructions from Manoj Kumar, Sr. Asstt. Punjab Irrigation Department has stated at the bar, that there are 19 such employees who have died or retired and their cases are being processed for the grant of pension. It is also submitted that the needfull shall be done within a period of six months provided that such employees, who have already been informed or are to be informed by the department, submits the required documents and fulfill the requisite conditions.

In view of the statement made by counsel for the State, the
present petition is accordingly disposed of.
