This petition is filed for taking appropriate action against the respondents in terms of Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts' Act, 1972 ('the Act') for the alleged disobedience of the order dated 30.06.2015 in which following direction was issued:-

“We direct the authorities in the Power Corporation to consider the claim of appellants sympathetically as and when such a representation is made and decide the same within a period of four months from the date of its receipt”.

After notice was issued in this case, the respondents filed reply along-with order dated 18.4.2016 deciding the representation of the petitioners though against them. Since the only direction of the Court was to decide the representation within a specified time, which has been decided,

there is no cause of action available to the petitioners to pursue this petition.

Accordingly, this petition is disposed of as having become infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order dated 18.4.2016, if so advised.
