The petitioner, which claims itself to be a Consortium of Farmers Associations, has filed the present petition alleging violation of the undertaking given before this court. The same is pertaining to payment to the farmers directly as against through Arhtias. The petitioner as such cannot be said to be aggrieved.

Learned counsel for the petitioner was not able to point out any fact mentioned in the petition or otherwise that any of the farmer had not received the payment even if the same had to be made through Arhtias. The petition is pending for the last more than six years.

Considering the aforesaid fact, in my opinion, continuation with the present petition at this stage will result in abuse of process of law. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
