Rajesh Bindal, J.

On 7.1.2016, the following order was passed:-

“The petitioners' writ petition was allowed entitling them to technical pay scales. The matter was tested before the Hon'ble Supreme Court where the judgment of this Court has been upheld. SLP having been dismissed on 24.11.2015 would thus leave no justification with the respondents to evade compliance.

The matter is, therefore, adjourned to 2.6.2016 as a measure of last opportunity to the respondents to comply with the orders of the writ Court dated 25.4.2012 within a period of 3 weeks from today positively failing which the Court shall proceed against the respondents on the presumption that they have wilfully disobeyed the orders of the writ Court.”

Affidavit of A.K. Gupta, Engineer-in-Chief, Irrigation & Water Resources Department, Haryana, dated 9.2.2016 has been filed stating that the order passed by this Court has been complied with. Even the payment of arrears to all the eligible petitioners has also been made. For delay in compliance, unconditional apology has been tendered.

Considering the aforesaid fact, prima facie, prayer in the present petition has been rendered infructuous, however, as none has appeared for the petitioners, the petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
