Pursuant to the order dated 02.5.2016, the petitioners have allegedly made a representation on 18.5.2016. It is submitted that though direction was issued to demarcate the land but speaking order has been passed by the Tehsildar, Mohali on 15.6.2016. The petitioners are,thus, aggrieved against the said order.

Be that as it may, insofar as the contempt petition is concerned, it is not maintainable but the petitioners have the liberty to challenge the said order in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
