The petitioner approached this Court alleging violation of the order passed by this Court on 21.3.2011 in CWP No. 5058 of 2011 Navneet Kaur Jeji vs State of Punjab and others. By the aforesaid order, it was directed that the petitioner, who was working on contractual basis will not be replaced by any other contractual employee. However, in case regular selection is made, the petitioner will have to make way for the regular appointee.

In the affidavit dated 13.10.2015, filed by Krishan Kaushik, Principal, Government College of Education, Patiala, it has been stated that the petitioner has not been replaced by any other contractual employee. Services of the petitioner as Guest Faculty Lecturer were required for only first semester of Session 2014-15, as there was no paper of fine arts in the second semester. Her services were required for the first semester of the current session 2015-16 and she was engaged. Hence, there is no violation of the order passed.

Considering the stand taken by the respondent in the reply filed, I do not find that any case is made out for violation of the order passed. The petition is accordingly dismissed.
