AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that the respondent(s) were supplied the certified copy of the judgment passed by this Court, contempt of which is alleged, in the month of December, 2014, which fact is not disputed by the respondent in the status report filed. Assuming that the respondent(s) were aware of the order passed by this Court on 31.12.2014, the petitioner would be entitled to the benefits of the judgment w.e.f. 01.05.2015 till the date of his superannuation, granting him all the benefits which he would have been entitled to on the post of Senior Assistant. For the subsequent period, he would be entitled to as per the extension policy. The said amount be released to the petitioner within a period of six weeks from today.

Disposed of with liberty to the petitioner in case the benefits which the petitioner is entitled to are not released to him as per the direction given above.
