AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

In compliance with the order passed by this Court on 18.10.2016 followed by the order dated 08.11.2016, Mr. T.K.Goyal, Director, Public Instructions (Colleges), Punjab, is present in Court and has filed reply by way of affidavit, wherein it has been stated that the claim of the petitioner has been duly considered and a speaking order passed on 14.12.2016 (Annexure R-1). It has further been stated that the petitioner is required to deposit the contributory fund with the competent authority along with 12% interest and on doing so, thereafter the consequential benefits will be released to her within a period of four weeks from the date of submission of proof of deposit of the amount.

When confronted by this Court of the order dated 03.12.2015 passed by this Court in CWP No. 25218 of 2015 and the instructions, then applicable, which have to be taken into consideration for charging interest, he, very fairly, concedes that the interest then was 10% and accordingly, the petitioner will have to deposit the amount along with 10% interest as per the instructions prevalent on the date of passing of the order by this Court. The amount due from the petitioner including the interest will be intimated to her within a period of two weeks from today and on depositing the same, the consequential benefits be released to the petitioner within a period of four weeks thereafter.

With these observations, the present contempt petition is disposed of. Petitioner, if so advised, and is aggrieved of any part of the order dated 14.12.2016, may avail of her remedy in accordance with law.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged subject to above.
