The grievance of the petitioner was that the order passed by this Court in her favour regarding payment of retiral dues along with interest had not been complied with.

The stand taken by the respondents in the reply filed by way of affidavit of K. K. Bhadoo, Director Public Instructions (Schools), Department of Education, Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh, dated 21.8.2014, is that the amount due to the petitioner in terms of the order passed by this Court has already been paid along with interest. While accepting the same, the present petition is disposed of. However, if there is any calculation error, the petitioner shall be at liberty to represent the competent authority, which shall consider the same.
