It is not disputed that the order of the Writ Court has been complied with, however, the petitioner states that amount has been released to him belatedly and accordingly prays for interest.

The Writ Court mandated a consideration on counting of army service towards pensionary benefits which have since been done.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that he would also be entitled to interest for the delayed payment.

On due consideration of the matter, I am of the opinion that the present petition needs to be disposed of as having been rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly and since benefits in terms of the orders of the Writ Court have already been granted to the petitioner, he would be at liberty to take recourse to his remedies in law for the interest component.
