Learned counsel for the petitioner states that during interregnum i.e. the date on which the case was taken up for hearing i.e. 16.08.2016, the initial date of hearing and today, the petitioner has been appointed on the post of Constable in Jalandhar (Rural) and he has joined as such on 10.10.2016. As regards the consequential benefits, which the petitioner was held entitled to i.e. granting him seniority from his merit position determined by the Recruiting Agency and for grant of benefits either notional or substantial are still remaining, for which the petitioner shall make a representation within a period of 10 days from today.

If such a representation is made by the petitioner, the same shall be considered and decided by the competent authority within a period of six weeks from the date of submission of such representation. Decision taken thereon shall be conveyed to the petitioner within a further period of

two weeks.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed  
of with above directions.
