The order dated 25.3.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents consider and decide the representations (Annexures P-5 and P-6 attached to the writ petition) in accordance with law, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case he is dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
