Rajesh Bindal, J.

In the earlier contempt petition bearing COCP No. 801 of 2012, this Court directed that in case the respondent-University needs to appoint new Guest Faculty, the claim of the petitioner shall be considered.

The stand of the respondent is that the petitioner was neither eligible at the time of initial appointment as he was given relaxation in the qualification nor he was eligible in any of the advertisement later on issued by the University for selection as Guest Faculty.

Considering the aforesaid submissions, the present petition is disposed of as there is already directions for consideration of the case of the petitioner in case he choses to apply for the post of Guest Faculty and is fully eligible.
