Short reply by way of affidavit of Col. Guljit Singh Chadha (Retd.)

Registrar, Punjab University, Chandigarh on behalf of respondents no.2 and 3 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The order dated 27.2.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners as contained in the representation (attached as Annexure P-6 with the writ petition) by passing a speaking order within a period of four months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with,

instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case they are dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
