This petition is filed for the alleged dis-obedience of the order dated 27.7.2017, in which a direction was issued that *“in case, the respondents have not already made appointments to the post of Assistant Professors against two posts in the Department of Electrical Engineering, the present petitioners would be permitted to continue”*.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that information about the order passed by this Court was supplied to the respondents by way of registered post on 28.7.2016. The receipt of the registered post is also attached with this petition. However, it is submitted that on 28.7.2016, itself, appointments to the post of Assistant Professors have been made.

In view thereof, there is hardly any ground for interference in this petition for the purpose of issuance of notice to the respondents because they have not willfully disobeyed the order of this Court.
