The order dated 29.4.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondent to take a decision on the representation dated 14.11.2014 (attached as Annexur P-9 with the writ petition) and legal notice dated 19.3.2015 (attached as Annexure P-10 with the writ petition) by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case he is dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
