The order dated 16.7.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondent no.2 to look into the matter and consider the grievance raised in petitioners' complaint dated 30.6.2015 (attached as Annexure P-1 with the writ petition) and decide the same strictly in accordance with law within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case they are dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
