Reply by way of affidavit of Dr. H.P.S.Bali, Director, Health and Family Welfare Punjab has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The order dated 14.7.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation to be made by the petitioner within a period of three weeks from the date of decision, by passing a speaking order within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the representation from the petitioner.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case he is dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
