Short reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Vijay Kumar, Estate Officer, HUDA, Bahadurgarh on behalf of the respondents has been filed in Court in (In COCN No.2145 of 2016), taken on record. Counsel for the State submits that this affidavit be read in the other connected contempt petitions.

Copy of the same have been given to the counsel opposite.

Learned counsel for the respondent-HUDA submits that two advertisements have already been issued calling for applications from the oustees for the plots reserved for them i.e. on 12.11.2016 and 29.11.2016 but none of the oustees have applied in response thereto. He, further, states on instructions from Sh. Vijay Kumar, Estate Officer, HUDA, Bahadurgarh that another advertisement is being contemplated to be issued within a period of one week from today, wherein, the last date for submission of the applications would be 23.01.2017. If the petitioners are keen to avail of the benefit of the oustees quota plots, they may apply for the same.

In view of the affidavit, which has been filed in Court as also the statement made by counsel for the respondent-HUDA, no contempt is made out as of now on the pleadings of the present cases and in view the facts and circumstances of the cases as it exists today.

In view of the above, these contempt petitions are disposed of with above observations.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
