The order dated 10.07.2014, the non compliance of which the petitioners allege, required the respondents of the writ petition to remit the arrears of the eligible persons within a period of two months, the compliance of which has since been made as has been stated at bar by the learned senior counsel appearing for the respondents, rendering the instant petition infructuous, which is disposed of accordingly, leaving the petitioners to their remedies in law in the event of their dissatisfaction against the order so passed.
