On 11.05.2015, while disposing of the writ petition, a direction was issued to the Additional Director General of Police (Crime Branch), Punjab to depute an IPS officer of the rank of S.S.P in his department to hold an enquiry into the allegations made by the petitioner while associating him in the said enquiry and conclude the same within a period of three months.

Reply by way of affidavit of Iqbal Preet Singh Sahota, IPS, Director, Bureau of Investigation, Punjab dated 16/17.02.2016 is filed today in court and copy is given to counsel for the petitioner, in which it is averred that enquiry has been completed and that a copy has been given to counsel for the petitioner where as, Shri R.S.Bains, counsel for the petitioner has submitted that no such copy has been given to him.

State counsel undertakes to supply a copy of the enquiry report to the counsel for the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition has become
infructuous.

Dismissed as infructuous.
