Reply has been filed which indicates that report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. was submitted on 26.8.2015. This petition was filed in January 2016 with the allegations that the official respondents have failed to abide by their own statement given on 9.5.2014 regarding submission of challan within a period of one month. Evidently, the instant petition is totally misconceived and the petitioner has tried to waste the time of the court by levelling allegations which are false. Even an affidavit to this effect has been filed.

Consequently, the contempt petition is dismissed with costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court within a period of two weeks.
