Reply by way of short affidavit of Anirudh Tewari, IAS has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The order dated 19.8.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation made by the petitioners by passing a speaking order within a period of 3 months.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case they are dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
