Counsel for the respondent has handed over a copy of the
appointment letter dated 15.09.2016 issued to the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that on two occasions,
petitioner has approached the Engineer-in-Chief, Haryana PWD (B&R)
Department, Chandigarh, but he has not been allowed to join.

This contention of the counsel for the petitioner is disputed by
the counsel for the respondent. He states, on instructions from
Shri Shiv Kumar, Assistant, that let the petitioner submit his joining report
with the Engineer-in-Chief, Haryana PWD (B&R) Department, Chandigarh,
on 26.09.2016 at 10 AM. Counsel for the respondent further states that the
petitioner shall be granted all consequential benefits as per the order passed
by this Court within a period of two months from the date of his joining.

In view of the above, the petitioner should join on 26.09.2016.

The contempt petition is disposed of in the light of the
statement given by the counsel for the respondent, on instructions,
as infructuous.

In the light of the disposal of the petition, pending applications stand disposed of as infructuous.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged.
