Compliance report by way of affidavit of Vikas Pratap, Secretary, Local Govt., Punjab on behalf of respondent no.1 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record.

The order dated 17.3.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice (attached as Annexure P-II with the writ petition) by passing a speaking order within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case they are dis-satisfied with the same. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
