The order dated 01.09.2014, the non compliance of which the petitioner alleges, required the petitioner of the writ petition to make a comprehensive representation as regards his grievance and on doing so, respondent no.2 to look into the same and take a final decision thereupon within a period of three months from the date of receipt of such representation, the compliance of which has since been made and speaking order passed as has been stated at bar by the learned counsel appearing for the respondent, rendering the instant petition infructuous, which is disposed of accordingly, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law in the event of his dissatisfaction against the order so passed.
