Affidavit of Shri Kulwinder Singh, Executive Engineer, Canal Lining Arrear Division, Tarn Taran at Amritsar, has been filed in Court, taken on record. Copy supplied to the counsel for the petitioner.

Counsel for the respondents, on the basis of the affidavit which has been filed in Court today, states that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with and the amount due to the petitioner stands released on 11.02.2016. Even the security amount of ₹91,779/- has been released to the petitioner and the receipt is appended as Annexure R-2.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the respondents, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to file a representation to Shri Kulwinder Singh, Executive Engineer, Canal Lining Arrear Division, Tarn Taran at Amritsar, within a period of two weeks.

If such a representation is filed, the same shall be considered and a decision taken thereon within a further period of six weeks.

In case some amount is further found due, the same be released to the petitioner within a period of three weeks thereafter.

A speaking order be passed in case the claim of the petitioner is not to be accepted and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
