AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner has approached this Court with a grievance that the order dated 15.03.2016 passed by this Court in Criminal Miscellaneous No.M-9099 of 2016 preferred by the petitioner has not been complied with by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar, whereby the representation dated 05.02.2015 submitted by the petitioner was to be looked into with regard to the grievances unfolded therein and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Counsel for the petitioner states that certified copy of the order was supplied to the respondent through registered post on 31.03.2016 and the respondent received the same by diary No.456-PTM dated 06.04.2016 but despite that, no action has been taken. Counsel contends that the petitioner had been approaching the respondent and his office but without any result. He prays for an adjournment to now approach the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar (Rural) pointing out this aspect.

If the petitioner approaches the respondent, the action taken on the representation of the petitioner be conveyed to him within a period of

two weeks from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

The contempt petition stands disposed of.
