This petition is filed for taking appropriate action against the respondent in terms of Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts' Act, 1972 ('the Act') for the alleged disobedience of the order dated 02.05.2016 in which direction was issued to D.C.Kurukshetra to call for the records and verify the petitioner's assertions and if any substance is found in the allegations, the State Government as well as the State Election Commission, Haryana, were directed to carry out necessary correction before the elections of Municipal Council, Kurukshetra are held.

In the reply filed by the respondents, it is submitted that the D.C Kurukshetra has not found any substance in the allegations made by the petitioner and, thus, the request of the petitioner has been turned down vide his order dated 10.5.2016.
