Reply on behalf of respondent No.3 by way of affidavit of Shri Parminder Singh Brar, District Education Officer, (Secondary Education), Faridkot and another reply on behalf of respondent No.2 by way of affidavit of Baldev Singh, District Education Officer (Elementary Education), Faridkot, have been filed in Court, which are taken on record, copies supplied to the counsel for the petitioners, according to which separate speaking orders have been passed in favour of the petitioners.
