The order dated 26.5.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-11 with the writ petition) by passing a speaking order within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and petitioners have been promoted and all arrears of pay have been released to them.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, leaving the petitioners to their remedies in law in the event of any shortfalls. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
