Writ petition was disposed of with direction to the respondent to take action wherein the prayer made by the petitioner was that some persons unauthorizedly occupied the village pond.

Reply by way of affidavit of Chander Shekhar Khare, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Panipat, dated 4.5.2016, filed today in Court is taken on record. It has been stated therein that the land in question was demarcated and ten persons were found as unauthorised occupants of Government land near Pond in village Azizullapur, which now falls within the Municipal Corporation, Panipat. Notices have been issued to the encroachers under Section 408-A of the Municipal Corporation Act, 1994 and they have challenged the same in the Civil Court.

Considering the aforesaid statement made in the affidavit filed, as the order passed by this Court has been complied with, nothing survives in the present petition. Accordingly, the petition is disposed of, however, with liberty to the petitioner to get the same revived if, even after decision of the Civil Court, any action required to be taken by the competent authority is not taken.
