By this order, I propose to dispose of two contempt petitions
i.e. *COCP No.2405 of 2016* titled as *Kulwinder Kaur Versus
Shri Suresh Arora* and *COCP No.2406 of 2016* titled as *Sukhwinder Singh
Versus Shri Suresh Arora*.

Petitioners have approached this Court alleging
non-compliance of a common order dated 21.04.2016 passed by this Court
in *CWP No.4341 of 2014* titled as *Kulwinder Kaur Versus State of Punjab
and others* and *CWP No.22313 of 2014* titled as *Sukhwinder Singh and
another Versus State of Punjab and others*. In the said order, directions
were issued to the Director General of Police, Punjab, to consider the claim
of the petitioners and pass a speaking order on the representation submitted

by the petitioners. As per the record and the pleadings, the order has been conveyed to the Commandant, Punjab Armed Force, Jalandhar, on 20.05.2016 (Annexure P-4). It appears that the order passed by this Court has not been conveyed to the respondent i.e. Director General of Police, Punjab.

Counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the present contempt petitions with liberty to approach the Director General of Police, Punjab, and supply him with the copy of the order passed by this Court, so that the same can be complied with.

This Court is sanguine that in case the petitioners approach the Director General of Police, Punjab, conveying the order passed by this Court in the writ petitions, the same shall be considered and appropriate orders as per the directions given by this Court, complied with within the time stipulated therein.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
