Affidavit of Anil Kumar Sharma, Senior Executive Engineer (P&M), Punjab State Transmission Corporation Ltd., Lalton Kalan Division, Ludhiana, dated 4.5.2016 filed in Court is taken on record.

It is stated therein that the amount has been sanctioned. The order passed by this Court has been complied with by passing of order dated 29.4.2016. The amount due to the petitioner shall be paid within a month after getting the pre-audit done. For delay in compliance, unconditional apology has been tendered.
