AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, it is apparent that the respondent(s) were supplied the certified copy of the judgment passed by this Court, contempt of which is alleged, in the month of January, 2015, which fact is not disputed by the respondent in the status report filed. Assuming that the respondent(s) were aware of the order passed by this Court on 31.01.2015, the petitioners would be entitled to the benefits of the judgment w.e.f. 01.05.2015 till the date of their superannuation, granting them all the benefits which they would have been entitled to on the post of Senior Assistant. For the subsequent period, they would be entitled to as per the extension policy. The said amount be released to the petitioners within a period of six weeks from today.

Disposed of with liberty to the petitioners in case the benefits which the petitioners are entitled to, are not released to them as per the direction given above.

Rule issued to the respondent stands discharged, subject to above.
